

# European Go Congress 2017

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When Russian Go Federation was made aware of the possible need for The European Go Federation to reassign the venue for EGC 2017 on short notice, we have volunteered to offer support in case of such emergency. We are extremely sorry that the congress in Turkey was cancelled. To save the event, we intend to put our maximum effort into organizing of the substitute congress, wherever it will be chosen to be held.

Although Russia did hold EGC in 2016, and it is not usual for a country to hold the congress for two years in a row, we think the circumstances may call for a special case. To make sure that the substitute congress will be a success we have the experienced team, we have the know-how, the resources, and our proposal for the venue is *the best* that Russia can offer.

## Sochi

Sochi is often called the unofficial 'Summer Capital' of Russia, or the Black Sea Pearl. This is the country's biggest and busiest summer sea resort, attracting more than four million visitors annually with its amazing mountainous coastline, endless shingle beaches, warm sunny days, and bustling nightlife. Sochi belongs to that tiny part of Russia, which is happily located in the subtropical climatic zone, enjoying 300 sunny days annually. The temperature of the Black Sea at the coast in summer sometimes reaches 30°C.

Sochi, and specifically The Olympic Park, has the entire infrastructure ready for the congress: venues, residence, food, transport, you name it. But it also offers limitless possibilities for recreation: amusement parks, aqua parks, pools, hiking, biking, bowling, all kinds of sports, night clubs, excursions, and, of course, beaches! This is *the* perfect place to spend your summer holidays, play Go and have lots of fun.



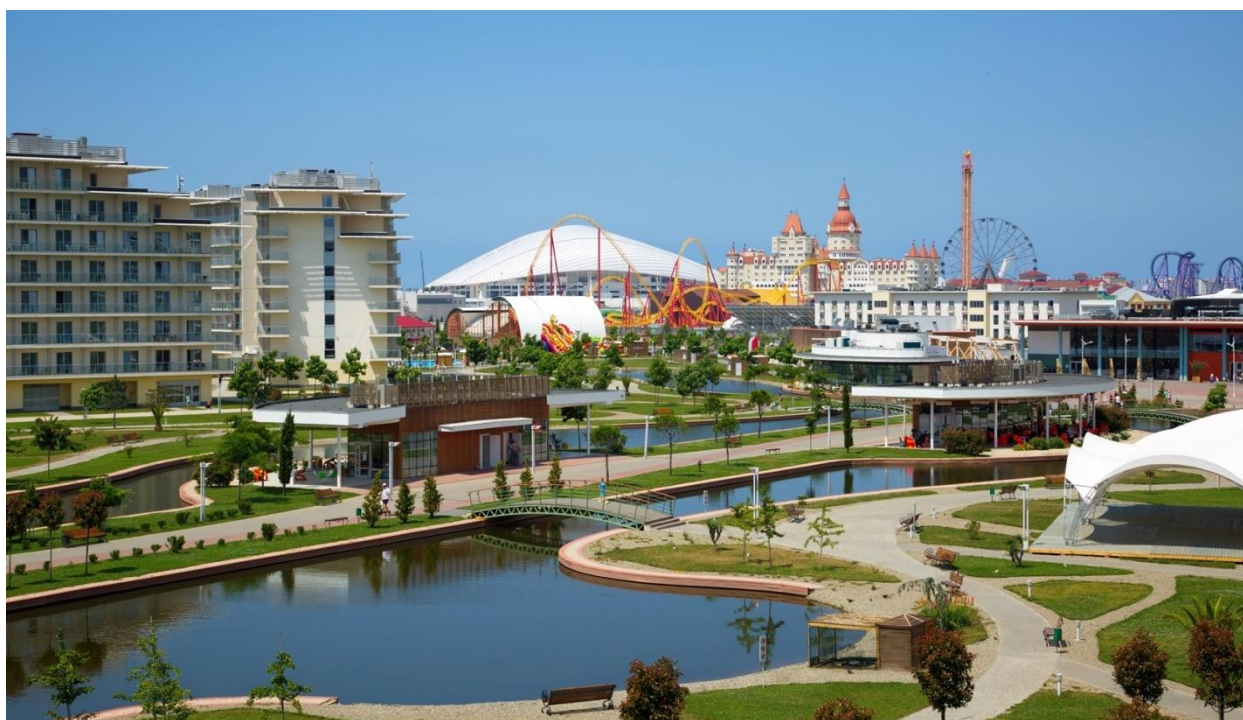
Diagram of Sochi

## The Venue

We offer AZIMUT Hotel Sochi 3\* as the main venue for the congress. The hotel grounds provide both indoors and outdoors areas that will be used for tournaments, free games, side events, recreation, registration/information desk and congress administration.

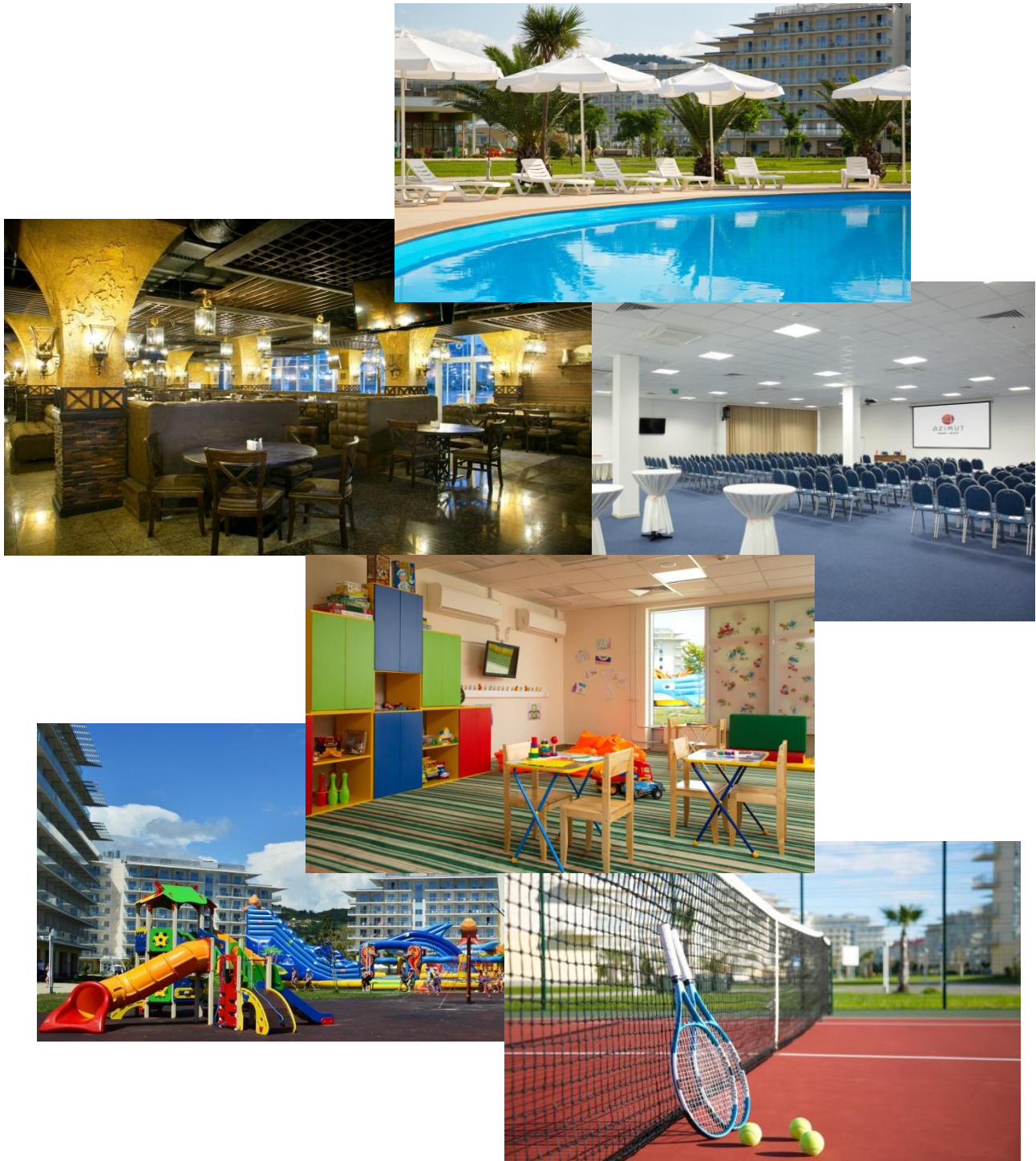
**AZIMUT Hotel Sochi grounds overview**

The hotel services and facilities that will be accessible to the congress participants include:

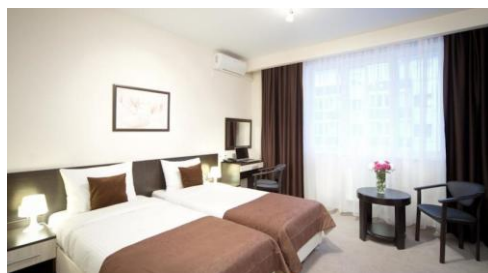

\* Direct flights from Berlin are currently available for February only, but it is expected that they will be scheduled for summer.

We have negotiations underway regarding arranging a charter flight from one of the Central European countries (probably Germany), but the results will be clear no sooner than in May.

The guests will arrive to Sochi International Airport (AER), from there we'll arrange free transfer to AZIMUT Hotel. If they somehow miss it, there are buses that can get them to the Olympic Park.

Sochi also has one of the cheapest taxi services in Russia (UBER-like). Getting from the airport to AZIMUT Hotel would cost you around 5 €.

The transport infrastructure of Sochi is well developed, featuring regular buses, minibuses and trains. Their routes and schedules will be made fully available in English, along with maps and other essential information. Free transport for EGC-supported events, excursions and tours will be arranged by the organizers.



# Visa

Acquiring visa is a standard procedure which is necessary when travelling between countries that haven't established some kind of visa-free agreement. Visitors from most European countries will need visa to enter Russia.

Visitors will have to choose their desired visa type, for example we recommend:

- Tourist visa – valid up to 30 days and allows a maximum of two entries. Invitation from the Russian Go Federation is not necessary
- Humanitarian visa – up to 365 days with no limit on the number of entries. This type of visa is intended for cultural, sports and charity purposes. Invitation from the Russian Go Federation required (and we will provide it upon request)

Regardless of the type of visa visitors are applying for, they will need to submit:

- original passport,
- application form,
- a recent passport-size photo,
- booking form.

Additional documents that may be required:

- bank statement,
- flight booking confirmation.

Standard processing time is 20 days.

Visa fee for EU citizens is 35 €.


We have substantial experience of helping individual visitors to get visa, so we will provide full support to everyone who would need it.

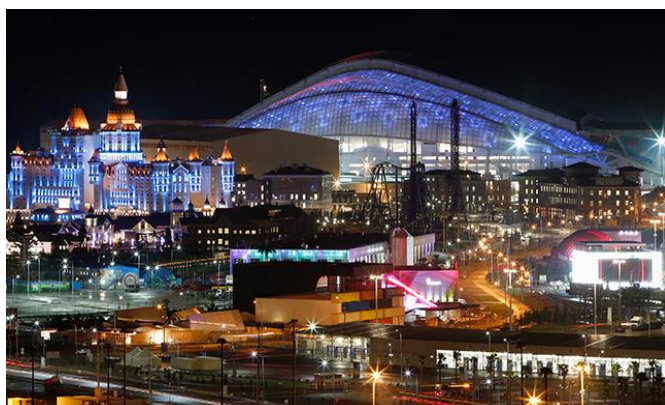
## Safety

We are aware that certain players consider visiting Russia or even Sochi in particular undesirable due to political or safety reasons. Although we expect the number of such individuals to be fairly low, we will be working together with European Go Federation to eliminate such concerns where it is possible.

Since Sochi held the XXII Olympic Winter Games in 2014, it has been utilizing its newly acquired infrastructure to hold numerous sports events and international conferences. It attracts a few million tourists (mostly from Russia) every year. The city authorities manage to ensure safety for all these proceedings without any major issues.

Speaking of the Olympics, the Olympic Park and Krasnaya Polyana house a number of sight worthy objects that remained from the games and are still occasionally used, definitely check those out. There is also Formula-1 track in the Olympic Park, which offers rides in sport cars, driven by you\*, or by a professional racer.

*\*If someone wants to drive the car himself, they'll have to pass a medical check, on-site extreme driving test and so on. Safety first!*

## Know-how

During the organizing of EGC 2016, our team has established numerous know-hows. These valuable pieces of knowledge, gained from the direct experience that is still fresh in the memory, will become the key assets in our race against time to make sure that all pieces of the huge puzzle, that EGC is, are in place. Here are some elements of our plan:

- Launch the congress website with all necessary information and open registration before 01 January 2017
- The minimal congress entry fee will not be raised until at least 01 May 2017
- Transfer registration of players that have already signed up for the Turkey's congress to our substitute congress upon their request
- Invite professional players from East Asia
- Provide support for congress participants that require visa
- Arrange direct charter flight to make it easier for players from Central Europe and organizers from joint European organizing team to get to the congress
- Put substantial effort into EGC opening and closing ceremonies, to make the congress unforgettable experience from the very beginning till the end
- Release an app that tracks congress schedule, tournament pairings and results
- Organize excursions, master-classes and other entertainment
- Organize sports side events
- Arrange free transport where possible
- Provide translators and guides where possible

## Conclusion

In our opinion, the perfect EGC 2017 would have been the one in Cappadocia, if only there were no such grievous obstructions set in the path of Turkish organizing team. But we do think that our proposal is worth a fair chance as a substitute, despite all of its perceived drawbacks.

You may wish to know why we are so eager to hold the congress. Every person who organized at least one small tournament in their life will know that carrying out an event may be a hard work, but the reward — seeing players come together under your roof and enjoy their favorite game — is truly satisfying. If you know how that feels, we're on the same page!

Regardless of which country will hold the congress, we will work hard together with the joint European organizing team, but to be able to fully utilize our own team's potential and resources and to provide the best experience for our guests, we need the congress to happen in Sochi.

We'd like to reiterate our plusses again:

- Great venue at the sea, perfect for sunny summer holiday
- Affordable residence options, possibly redeeming somewhat costly travel expenses
- Food and drinks that will satisfy any taste, for very low prices
- Virtually limitless possibilities to have fun in Sochi
- Solid sponsor and decent budget, allowing for greater prize pool and better service
- The team with experience and know-how, already working even as you read this
